- *Enrollment in the appropriate section of HWC 205/115: Western Civilization II or HWC/ARCH 600: Biography of a City: London during the semester in question*

Scholarship applications must include the following items:

- *A Seaver scholarship application form*
- *A one-page statement describing the applicant's interest in the Program*
- *A copy of the applicant's current KU DPR*
- *The name of one KU faculty reference (HWC instructors preferred)*
